## WIL-MAR LADIES' LEAGUE KICKOFF BRKEAFAST AND MEETING, MARCH 2, 2020

President Mary Williams called the meeting to order. Present were 60 members and two guests, Fran Wilkerson and Robbie Glad. Following a prayer by Rhonda Davis everyone enjoyed the breakfast.

The following new members were recognized and welcomed: Dana Delfino, Lisa Gallond, BB Hardy, Cathy Szerelmey, June Small, Pam Hamilton, and Andrea Rutherford.

The minutes from the End of Year Luncheon in November were accepted as read. Suzy Walker presented the budget for the 2020 year. She said that we have 77 paid members. She also thanked everyone for paying ahead of the breakfast! A motion to accept the budget was made by Gerry Dunham and seconded by Antho Moody.

Next were the chairpersons' reports:

Tournaments - Mary Ann Carver presented the tournaments for the playing season and recognized her co-chair, Dede TeStrake. Others on her committee are Antho Moody, Faye Wade, Sara Gosnell, Barbara Kramarcy, and Mary Williams.

Ringers - Midge Jones showed everyone what the ringer card looks like this year. Players will record their scores and their putts on one side and their birdies on the other side so that all scoring will be on one card. The hole-in-one pot is up to \$320 now. Members should see Midge if they want to participate in this and haven't done so already.

Records: Mary Scott Honbarrier said that the goal this year is NO errors in score keeping on the Wil-Mar scorecards. Errors=no points. Please ask for help, especially during the beginning of the season. Mary Scott will be around to help and other members can help as well. March is the month to practice.

Mary Introduced Fran who also said that March is the month to practice. To help tune up everyone's game she will have two Reboot clinic days: Wednesday, March 4th, 10-12:30 and Tuesday, March 10th, 10-12:30. Cost is \$50. Please let her know if you plan to come.

Fran also talked about the condition of the course which is good, considering the winter that we've had. There is a new course superintendent, Lane Johnson, who comes from Prestonwood. The greens are in great putting condition and very fast!

Next to speak was Robbie Glad who is the club's direct contact with the ladies league. Among the topics he covered are:

A. Change in the handicap system. We will post our gross score hole by hole instead of the total score. The system understands our handicaps and will make the adjustment hole by hole.

The system updates every day instead of the 1st and the 15th of the month. He let us know that our course handicap for Wil-Mar will go down and he will post the handicaps every Monday.

We will use posting buddies to help with posting hole by hole in GHIN. It will go much faster and more accurately that way. We should post THAT day. Robbie will give a warning, and if that is disregarded, he will post a PAR for that member.

B. When we sign up to play golf, please indicate if you are playing just 9 holes. Those ladies will be sent off together.

C. When we sign in on Mondays, Robbie will draw the chips for our starting holes and show each chip to the player as she checks in.

D. Walkers should check in with the others in your foursome and remain with them until everyone is sent out to their starting holes. Robbie would like to begin the day with everyone together for a "Rule of the Day". A little education...

E. Play will begin on the red tee with the player who is ready beginning the play. From that point on ready play is in force. Go to your ball as soon as possible with three clubs so that you will be able to make your decision about which club you want to use. Be ready to hit when it is your turn OR let the other players know when you are hitting out of turn. Keep your putter until you reach the next tee, where you will write down your score.

Mary introduced that league's Local Rules - three changes: At the first tee of play, ladies will hit according to who is ready. Then ready play is in effect. 2nd: the Alternative Stroke and Distance Rule for Lost Ball or Out of Bounds Ball. Please read this in the rules. 3rd: Handicaps. Three rounds will establish a handicap. The highest handicap in this league will be 36, in line with the Fun Golfers League at Wil-Mar.

Mary introduced Antho who presented her church's tournament on April 18.

Door Prizes were presented by Beverly Stenzel, who put them together.

The motion to adjourn the meeting was made by BB Hardy and seconded by Judy Blaylock.
